

Paper Trail: Round & Challenge Tracker

Round Tracker Sheets help you keep an eye on which Challenges have entered the game, how long they have been hanging around, and whether your team actually dealt with them.

At the end of every Decision Round, the player who drew the Challenges updates the sheet. Mark every round in which a

Challenge remains active. If your team solves it, mark it as Solved (✓). If it survives unresolved for six active rounds, mark it as Missed (Δ), add +1 Δ Fragility, and discard it together with any Solution Cards committed to it.
